



Did you know most foreign nationals who were present in the U.S. for any portion of a given calendar year (Jan 1 - Dec 31) are required by law to file a tax return and/or accompanying forms with the federal Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and all appropriate state tax offices?

FREE ASSISTANCE

➤ Tax Assistance with GLACIER Tax Prep – Non-resident federal returns only

If eligible, you may use **GLACIER Tax Prep** (formerly known as **CINTAX**) to complete the correct U.S. income tax form (either Form 1040NR or Form 1040NR-EZ), prepare any additional statements or attachments, as applicable (Form 2106, Form 8843, Schedule C, and/or Scholarship/Fellowship Grant statement), and print the tax return and all attachments. Note that **GLACIER Tax Prep** is only available for federal returns. State returns must be filed using another method.

Washington University makes **GLACIER Tax Prep** available at no cost to Washington University sponsored students and scholars. The program will be accessible in mid-February, and an e-mail with instructions and an access code will be sent at that time. If it is the end of February, and you have not received an e-mail, complete the access code request form on our website, <http://oisshome.wustl.edu/tax.html>.
